
SUBJECT: GUIDELINES FOR TICK CONTROL MEASURES AND ARRANGEMENT DURING EID UL AZHA 2021 BY L&DD

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that Eid-ul-Azha 2021 is just around the corner, hefty transportation / movement of sacrificial animals from amongst the provinces is anticipated on the conventional routes. Pursuant to the instructions of Government of the Punjab, the following guide lines are hereby notified to ensure control measures to avoid any unpleasant predicament:

1. Spray of ticks/fly repellent at the sale yard/sale point shall be carried out by the veterinary staff deputed at the said sale point.
2. Banners at each sale point (which is notified by concerned DC) shall be displayed for free veterinary service delivery.
3. One branded vehicle/wagon having loud speaker shall be allocated for each sale point. Sufficient quantity of medicines/vaccines shall be provided to mobile veterinary dispensary for free treatment of diseased animals of all kinds. Mobile Ambulance with loud speaker shall make regular announcements for treatment of sick animals at door steps in Mohalla/street/town in urban areas.
4. One Veterinary Officer, One Veterinary Assistant and one Cattle Attendant shall move with each mobile veterinary dispensary.
5. As per previous year practice daily report shall be prepared and also same be updated the daily activities on social media.
6. Concerned Divisional Director Livestock and ADL of the district shall ensure the availability of anti-ticks spray, stomach powder and medicines/dextrose etc.
7. Director Livestock Rawalpindi, Sargodha, D.G Khan and Bahawalpur division shall establish pickets only at entry points of inter-provincial borders to ensure the disinfection/anti-ticks spray of animals coming from other provinces to Punjab. The staff shall wear the proper dress (caps etc) and camps shall be

- markets regarding disease incidences and generated a report, the same may be exercised for this year and a fresh report may be generated.
9. *Camps with proper banner shall also be established at entry gates on main road of PRI Rawalpindi, VRI Lahore, RCCIB Jhang, LSTCs and BRI Kasur for providing veterinary coverage to all animals to be sold for sacrificial purpose.*
 10. Banners shall be displayed to facilitate pregnancy test.
 11. **Spray of animals to be sold in regular Cattle Mandies (other than sacrificial animals) is the responsibility of Cattle Management Company concerned.**
 12. Director General (Ext/) L&DD Punjab with the request to ensure the control measures accordingly.
